

**Langford Public Library Trustees
October 5, 2021 Meeting**

The Langford Public Library Trustees met on October 5, 2021. The meeting was called to order at 3:39pm by President Melody Swearingen. Those present were Melody Swearingen, Brandi Fries, Savannah Person, Kellie Alberts, Kaitie Stiegelmeier and Nicole Hoines.

The minutes of the last quarterly meeting were read by Nicole. Brandi made a motion to approve the minutes as read and the motion was seconded by Melody.

The Treasurer's Report was given by Savannah. Total funds, including CD's, balanced at \$8,192.93. Brandi motioned to approve the Treasurer's Report as read. Melody seconded. Brandi motioned to approve the first quarter expenditures and Melody seconded the motion.

Old Business: Nicole updated the board on the One Book SD event that took place and that the new computer has been very helpful.

New Business: Nicole updated the board on how the various programs are going and others that are in the works, including a Cricut workshop and Lego Club.

Lindsey Kimber from GLAD said we could use the remaining \$89.75 from the TREP\$ program for other programs for all ages and she also sent another \$550.00 to be used toward that, as well. A Gignerbread Contest was discussed and Nicole will reach out to Cari Price about Santa Days and Paula Jensen about Christmas Open House, to determine a contest timeline and dates. Nicole updated the board about the Technology visit from the State Library Technology Coordinator and about WhoFi. We now are able to offer WIFI to patrons and are able to track the numbers of people using it, but not what they use it for. Nicole will continue to move forward with applying for eRate (the cost-sharing program for Libraries) as she found out it will roughly pay for about 50% of the internet costs. An open house was discussed, and a date can be set after Nicole talks to other community members about their events. Nicole will figure out door prizes and food. The next meeting will be on December 7, 2021 at 4:00 p.m.
