

UPCOMING ELECTRIC WORK

Sean Kramer, Utility Manager, and Mitchell Wieser, Assistant Utility Manager, are currently enrolled in a four-year training program administered by the Minnesota Municipal Utilities Association (MMUA).

This program includes onsite instructor-led training; which means the electrical instructor comes to Langford, teaches our employees first-hand how tasks are done, while working on our own services.

The instructor will be in Langford on August 26-27, 2024. Alongside Kramer and Wieser, the instructor will teach and assist with replacing meter sockets and burying two electrical lines. Burying the electrical lines will convert it from being an over-head service to an under-ground service.


