

REBATES FROM HEARTLAND ENERGY

Heartland Energy has released their rebate amounts for 2025. The rebate amounts for <u>heat pumps</u> and <u>water</u> <u>heaters</u> increased, while the amount for commercial lighting, commercial refrigeration, and EV charging remained the same as past years.

Important reminders:

- It is <u>no longer</u> required for equipment to be ENERGY STAR rated.
- Rebate amounts are only available on equipment installed after January 1, 2025.

HEAT PUMP REBATES.

- Ducted Electric Air-Source Heat Pump, 2 tons or larger: \$1,000 (formerly \$600)
- Ducted Electric Air-Source Heat Pump with Backup Electric Furnace or Boiler: \$2,000 (formerly \$1,200)
- Non-ducted Mini Split Heat Pump: \$500 (formerly \$300)
- Geothermal Heat Pump with Electric Backup: \$2,000 (formerly \$1,200)

WATER HEATER REBATES.

- Lifetime warranty electric water heater: \$20/gallon of tank capacity (formerly \$200 or \$400 depending on size)
- Standard electric water heater (did not previously offer a rebate on these models):
 - 50-79 gallons: \$150
 - 80 gallons or larger: \$300
- Electric heat pump water heater: \$400





COMMUNITY CENTER RENOVATION

The Town will begin renovations in the Community Center, located on Main Street. The renovation will consist of a new false-ceiling being installed, new flooring in the Community Room & the former Finance Office, along with new paint throughout the building.

Upon completion of these updates, the Town will display community & town-oriented items from the past & current for the public's viewing pleasure. Some of these items include the original wooden street signs, ice scraper from Swede's, an iron claw from Langford's prior police department, a Langford Boy Scout flag, and the Town's original plat from on onion-paper.

BOARD APPROVES STREET PROJECT FOR 2025

At the most recent Board Meeting, the Board motioned to approve a bid from Jensen Rock & Sand for a 2025 street project. Two bids were received; one from Bituminous Paving and one from Jensen Rock & Sand. The bid amounts are as follows:

1.Bituminous: \$302,500.00

2. Jensen Rock: \$293,900.00

The project will consist of a chip seal & fog seal throughout Town, while some streets will receive a double chip seal.

The start date will be late-spring to early-summer, while the completion date must be October 1, 2025.




