Wednesday, April 16, at 6:30PM





LANGFORD FUN-FACTS

The information below was located in the Langford Centennial Book.

FUN FACTS

- The first business in Langford was a Hardware Store.
- In 1892 a Langford gentlemen, named William Mann, helped build the first gas-engine tractor. Mann built the tractor with the inventor, John Froelich, from Froelich, Iowa. The tractor was first used in the Langford Area for threshing. It was used for 52.5 days without problems. Froehlich manufactured the tractor under the name "Waterloo Boy", until the John Deere Company purchased the company in March 1918.
- In the early 1900's, most stores in Langford remained open until midnight on Wednesday and Saturday nights!
- In 1901 the bounty for gopher tails was \$0.03.
- In 1902 the Langford Bugle had a list of 65 things Langford had to offer. The following are six of those items:
 - 1. Six farm machinery dealers
 - 2. Three general merchandise stores
 - Two dressmakers
 - 4. One jewelry store
 - 5. Two blacksmiths
 - 6. A few old maids, also several good looking bachelors
- In 1918 Langford had a total of 6 grain elevators.
- In 1942 the Langford Study Club organized & started the Langford Public Library.
- In 1986, Langford's centennial year, the population was approximately 300.
- Langford previously had a Langford Opera House on Main Street, which is now known as the Legion Hall.
- In the early years of the Langford Library, they were burglarized and the following four items were stolen: 1) typewriter, 2) rag rug, 3) very old dictionary, and 4) money in the amount of \$2.00.
- Highlanda Lutheran Church had a band and they were known as the Highlanders.
