

Unapproved Minutes of
Special Session of Board of Trustees
Monday, September 30, 2013

The Langford Board of Trustees met Monday, September 30, 2013 at the Finance Office. President Todd Sell called the meeting to order at 6:15 p.m. with Trustee Chad Hardy, Trustee Orville Helgeson, and Finance Officer Melody Swearingen in attendance, along with Marcia Reints.

The Application for Variance submitted by Robert and Deloris Bruns for placement of a house on Lot 9 of Block 15 was reviewed; no one attended to object. Helgeson made a motion to approve the application; seconded by Hardy; motion carried.

The following requests for building permits were reviewed and approved: Robert and Deloris Bruns – governor's house at Lot 9, Block 15; Milton Hardy – storage shed at 210 Hickory; and Margie Liknes – shingle replacement at 302 Park St.

Swearingen reported on correspondence from the SD Dept of Revenue which notifies the City that we have been overpaid for sales tax revenues in the amount of \$8,431.90. Helgeson made a motion to instruct the SD Dept. of Revenue to withdraw funds for overpaid sales tax revenues from future payments until the entire balance is repaid, vs. a payment plan; seconded by Hardy; motion carried.
